Dear Parent/Carer,

Since I arrived at De Lacy as Headteacher, I have spent a lot of time with the Year 6 pupils and getting to know them as individuals. If your child does gain a C3, one of the Year 6 team will contact you to discuss the choices made and the consequence of your child's actions.

Please can you support your child and school by discussing this letter with them, and helping them understand the importance of being a positive role model and member of De Lacy Primary School so that they can enjoy the end of their time at De Lacy.
