### **Advance Notice of Marrick Priory Residential Visit**

Dear Parents/ Carers,

We are currently organising a residential visit to the **Marrick Priory Centre** in Richmond. The visit will take place next year, beginning on **Monday 5th February 2024 until Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2024** and is available for children in **Year 3,4 and 5**.

The visit is a fantastic opportunity for children to experience a wide range of activities including ropes courses, zip wire over the River Swale, climbing, and archery all within a controlled and safe environment as well as developing team building and social skills.

The cost of the visit will be £165.00 per child. This will include all accommodation, food, travel and activities. Specialist equipment is provided by the Centre. Places on the visit are now open and we will be collecting non-returnable deposits of £20.00 via the MCAS, consent and deposit needs to be completed on MCAS no later than 20<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The balance can be paid in instalments, and we can accommodate a payment plan if needed. Children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding will receive a 30% discount. The trip must be paid for via MCAS.

*(Non-returnable deposit refers to withdrawal of the child by parents/carers or by the school due to serious concerns about a child's behaviour. Subsequent payments will also be forfeited in the case of withdrawal unless the place can be filled by another child)*

**Please note, if we receive insufficient interest in the visit, then the trip may be cancelled.**

If the trip is cancelled by school, then any payments made will be refunded.
