Scholastic Book Fair & Bookmark Competition

Dear Parents and Carers

We are very excited to inform you that De Lacy Primary will be running a Scholastic Book Fair from Monday 26th February to Thursday 29th February 2024. The Book Fair will be open between 3:20pm-4:00pm for you and your child to come and browse and buy. This week, you will receive a World Book Day token which can be used at the fair as part payment towards a book. There will be a wide variety of titles to choose from, with book prices starting from only £2.99.

We are organising a competition over the half term, 'Design a Bookmark'. With this letter we will provide a bookmark template for your child to get creative. Some ideas have been provided on the reverse of this letter to help inspire your child. The entries will be judged in school and 5 lucky winners will be awarded with a £5 voucher that they can use at the book fair. All entries need to be brought back into school on or before Tuesday 20th February 2024 and should include your child's name. Good luck!

When visiting and purchasing any books at the fair, payment will be card only via a QR Code that you can scan on your mobile phone. You will pay for the book via the QR Code, and it will generate a receipt. You will then show the member of staff who will provide you with your order. This will be a cashless event.

Children can also fill out a 'wish list' of books and their cost, which you can take home. If you wish to purchase any of the books on their wish list, payment can be made online at bookfairs.scholastic.o.uk/pay. After making payment online you will receive payment code which the child must bring into school to collect their books, along with their wish list indicating which book/books were paid for. If the book of their choice is out of stock at the fair, you can still order and this will arrive at school at the later date of Monday 4th March 2024.

As well as providing an opportunity for the children to spend their World Book Day tokens, and take home a quality book to enjoy, every book bought will help towards new books for our school library for free! We look forward to seeing you and the children during the Scholastic Book Fair and thank you in advance for supporting this great event and helping us to raise funds to obtain new books and resources for our library.
