Instead of a donation of money, we ask that you donate a bottle of your choice. For example, bottle of pop, alcohol, shampoo - anything that is sold in a bottle. All bottles donated will help to set up a tombola stall at the Fayre. Items will be accepted from **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June** until **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June**.

I would just like to thank you again for your continued support and for always helping with the events we organise as a school.

We hope to see you at the Summer Fayre on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 3:30pm – 4:30pm. Please collect your child as normal at 3:20pm and exit the playground and wait at the front of school. We will then have the gate at the opposite side of school open for entrance to the Fayre.

The Summer Fayre will include Class Stalls, Tombola, Ice Cream Van, Face Painting, Refreshment Area and even an appearance from the Local Police and Fire Service. In order for you to be able to participate in as many activities as possible, please may we ask that you bring the appropriate change, as school do not carry any cash. Please see the following price list, so you can plan accordingly -

Class Stalls – 50p per play

Tombola - £1.00 for 5 tickets

Hot Drink & Bun - £1.00

Lastly, can we please remind all parents that whilst the Fayre is taking place, toilets will NOT be accessible unless you have a medical exemption, for which evidence must be provided.
